Board Consideration of Ordinance 2025-06-19 to Amend Title II, Division 1, Chapter 2, Article 3 – Speed Regulations of the Town of Washington Municipal Code to Amend the Speed Limit on Markgraff Rd (Schumacher Rd to USH 12) to 45 mph.

Admin. Henning stated that a resident requested this section of Markgraff have a lower speed limit and due to the terrain, it is consistent with the other roads in the area.

RD (SCHUMACHER RD TO USH 12) TO 45 MPH. The motion was seconded by Supv. Mueller.
